**Regional Workshop on
WEEE/E-waste Management
(6th – 9th July 2010)**

UNEP Governing Council decision (GC 25/8) on Waste Management acknowledges the work UNEP-DTIE-IETC is undertaking in the field of waste management. It requests the Executive Director of UNEP to provide further assistance to developing countries in their efforts to strengthen national implementation of an Integrated Waste Management (IWM) approach. Bali Declaration on Waste Management for Human Health and Livelihood of the Basel Convention further supports the implementation of this decision.

In order to implement these decisions, UNEP-DTIE-IETC in partnership with other organizations is implementing various programmes based on 3R (reduce, reuse and recycle) approach focusing on integrated solid waste management, waste electrical and electronics equipment (WEEE)/E-waste, waste agricultural biomass, waste plastics and hazardous waste management.

This workshop is organized to build local capacity on WEEE/E-waste management and to discuss current challenges. The objectives of this workshop are:

1. To provide training on developing WEEE/E-waste management plan to the participants from Asia-Pacific region; and
2. To discuss the challenges in WEEE/E-waste management with various stakeholders and share expertise and experiences.
